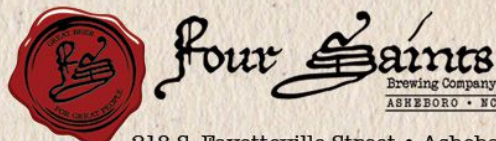
Light Bodied, Golden-Amber,

The Quick Sell: A bright, refreshing, slightly citrus beer with a little funk and some bright hops.

Brettanomyces, originally isolated from strong English stock beer, is said will help a beer achieve English character. What English character actually means is up for debate. What we do know is that this saison is 100% oak fermented and full of flavor. This beer's dry, crisp, and refreshing light citrus flavor is complemented with a double dry-hopping of Citra and Mosaic hops and slight Brett funk that, whether it's of English character or not, will certainly have you in a jolly mood.
