

"The world's largest walk-through zoo in the world, containing over 2,000 acres of land mass, and home to over 1,600 animals from 250 different species is located RIGHT HERE in Asheboro, NC.

The North Carolina Zoo is seven miles from Four Saints Brewing Company, and this is our FIRST collaborative beer we've brewed with the North Carolina Zoo Society to support their world-leading conservation efforts.

The American red wolf was once the apex predator in the southeastern U.S., but the wolf was declared extinct in the wild 40 year ago. A recovery program then introduced the American red wolf to the Alligator River National Wildlife Preserve. Today the entire American red wolf population consists of about 250 wolves under human care and about 15 wolves in the wild.

American red wolf conservation is just one North Carolina Zoo project highlighted in the new series from Nat Geo WILD, "Secrets of the Zoo: North Carolina." The series debuted Saturday, Oct. 31, and episodes run each Saturday through Dec. 19.

Our Red Wolf Red IPA is a medium-bodied hoppy beer with a complex yet clean taste profile. 10 percent of proceeds of all Red Wolf Red IPA sales will benefit American red wolf conservation efforts at the North Carolina Zoo.
